A. Robert Bolton -- His Lordships the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary commanded the
D. William Lord Jnd. Garnishee Sheriff of Somerset County by his writ in these words following d^r. Somerset
of Robert Holland -- b. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland &
Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore. To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we
command you that you attach any his goods Chattels Rights or Credits of Robert Holland late of Somerset
County Merchant if they shall be found in your bailiwick to the value of One hundred and three pounds
fifteen shillings and two pence curr. money & two thousand pounds of tobacco and when you have the
same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same
before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the Third Tuesday
of March Next there and there to be condemned according to act of Assembly to and for the use of
a certain Robert Bolton unless the said Robert Holland by himself or his Attorney shall appear
and answer unto the said Robert Bolton in a g^eal of trespass upon the said & according to Law and
that by good and lawfull men of your bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons
in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our
Justices of Our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or they have why the
same Goods Chattels Right or Credits so attached in his her or their hands Ought not to be condemned
and Execution thereof had and made according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided
if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writt that you make
known unto our said Justice at the day and place aforesaid have you then and there this writt
Witness Robert King Gent. Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty ninth day of November
in the Nineteenth Year of Our dominion & Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and thirty
three — At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the nineteenth day of the same
month and Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and thirty three being the day of the return of the said
writt come the said Robert Bolton by ffrauncis Deller his Attorney and the Sher^r of Somerset
County to whom the foregoing writt was directed likewise comes and makes return thereof to
the Court here Endorsed — By virtue of the within writt to me directed to the Justice of
Somerset County I do certify that on the second day of March One thousand seven hundred and
thirty three I did attach of the goods & chattels of the within named Robert Holland to the
value of one hundred and three pounds fifteen shillings and two pence currant money and two
thousand pounds of tobacco in the hands of Samuel Hopkins Jnd. and William Lord Jnd. and I do
further certify that before Joshua Merrill and Richard Roe Good and lawfull men of my
bailiwick I have made known to the aforesd. Samuel Hopkins Jnd. and William Lord Jnd. that they
e and appear at the time and place appointed So A. over J. Caldwell Sher^r

And the aforesd William Lord Jnd. Garnishee of the aforesd Robert Holland by George Douglas his attor-
ney comes and prays leave to Imparls here until his next Court and he hath it and the same day
is given to the aforesd Robert Bolton here also &c

All which said next Court to wit the eighteenth day of June and Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred
and thirty four come againe as well the aforesd Robert Bolton as the aforesd William Lord Jnd. Garnishee as
ef
