Judgement if the afo Robert Bolton Condemnation of the premises so as afo attached in his  
hands to have ought &c. And the afo Robert saith that he by any thing in the afo  
Def P. plea above alledged from having Condemnation & Execution of the goods aforesd was aforesd  
in the return of the writ of Attachment above mentioned to be attached in the hands of him the  
said William Ought not to be barred because he saith that he the said William at the time of  
the Impetration of the writ of Attachment aforesd and at the day of the laying of the attachment  
aforesd in the hands of him the afo Robert had Goods Chattels Right & Creditts of the aforesd Robert  
Holland in his hands to the value of the sum in the return of the attachment mentioned —  
and this he pray may be Inquired of by the Country & — and the afo William Lord Jnd in like manner

Thereupon it is Commanded the Sher. of Somerset County that Immediately he should cause to come

and further it is Considered that the afo William Lord Jnd Recover against the afo Robert Bolts.
