Or to say knoweth wherefore the said Sarah Stewart her Execution of the Judgment afd. against the said James Shirley ought not to have if to him it seemeth Expedient, and have you then and there the Names of those by whom to him you make the same known and this writt Willeys-Prob. King Gent. Chiefe Justice of the said Court the Twentieth Day of March in the Eighteenth Year of our Dominion to Anna Dowd one thousand Seven hundred and thirty two

At which said Third Tuesday of June to witt the Nineteenth day of the same Month Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty three before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset held at Dividing Crook in the County afd. came the aforesaid Sarah Stewart Adm^r as aforesaid by Francis Allen her Attorney and the Sher of Somerset, to witt Joshua Caldwell Gent. at the same Day Returned that he by Virtue of the writt afd. to him Directed had made known unto the afd. James Shirley by Joshua Merrill & David Polk honest and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick that he be and appear before his said Lordships Justices at the day and place afores. to show &c. as within to him it was Commanded And the afd. James Shirley so forwarde; and at the same Day being solemnly Called Cometh not but makes Default.

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Sarah Stewart Adm^r of the same John Stewart have Execution against the same James Shirley of the Damages afd. according to the force form and Effect of the Recovery afd. &c.
