Whittington of a plea of trespass upon the Goods of the said Susannah wordie And whereupon William by Francis Eldon his attorney complains that whereas the said Susannah the tenth day of march and Dom Seventeen hundred and thirty One at Somerset County afores. within the Jur. of this Court was indebted unto the said William in Six pounds current money of maryland for One Yoke of Oxen to her sold and delivered as by Acc. hereunto annexed may in Court appear and being so thereof indebted the said Susannah in Consideration thereof the day & year afores. at Somerset County afores. within the Jurisdiction afores. upon her self did assume and did assume and to the said William then and there did faithfully promise that she the said Six pounds to the said William when she should be thereunto requested she would well and faithfully pay and Content Nevertheless the said Susannah her promise and assumption afores. in form afores. made nothing regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending the said Wm. in that part craftily and Subtly to deceive and defraud the afores. Money to the said William although the same to do the said Susannah by the afores. William on the afores. tenth day of march in the Year afores. and often afterwards at Somerset County afores. within the Jur. afores. she was thereunto requested hath not paid or to him for the same in any sort Contented but the same to him he thereto to pay or in any sort to Content hath refused and still doth refuse & deny whereupon he saith he is wronged and hath damages to the Value of twelve pound. the money and thereof he brings suit &c.
