Therefore it is Considered by Consent of the parties of that the said William Whittington Recover against the said Susannah Wordie his Damages of to the said five pounds twelve shillings & six pence Current money in form of Confessed as also Two hundred & forty three --- pounds of balance for his Costs and Charges of to the same William by the Court here and Consent of the parties of as judged and the said Susannah in mercy &c.

And the said Francis Elliott by Francis Allan his attorney comes and defends the force and Injury whereof and prays Leave thereof to be made honorable the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the said Samuel Beckley & Lewis Howel here also &c.
