And the said Dennis Hudson by Francis Allen his attorney comes and defends the force and injury where and pray leave thereof to Imparle herewith next Court and he hath it & the same day is given to the affd Levin Gale herealso &c.

At which said next Court to witt the twentieth day of August and Dord One thousand seven hundred and thirty four came again as well the affd Levin Gale by his attorney and as the affd Dennis Hudson by his attorney affd and because the affd Levin Gale did not declare against the said Dennis Hudson in the plea affd according to a certain rule of Court by the parties affd Entred into &c. Therefore he and his pledges of prosecuting be in mercy and lett the plaintiff name pledges & and that the affd Dennis Hudson goe thereof without day also it is considered that the affd Dennis Hudson recover against the affd Levin Gale his damages by Occasion of the premises to one hundred &

Ninty four pounds of tobacco to the same Dennis Hudson by discretion of the Justices here at his request for his costs and charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute thereof lately made and provided &c.
