And the aforesaid Capel King Executor of the same Benjamin King by Francis Allen his attorney ^{comes} Defendant his free and injury whom he and saith that he cannot gainsay the action aforesd of the affd John no can he say but that the affd Benjamin in his life did affirms upon himself in manner and form as the affd John above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same John by him by Occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Capell saith and confesseth that the affd John has sustained damages by Occasion of the premises further than his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to the affd Twelve pounds Eleven Shillings & Ten pence Current money of Maryland & not more to be levied of the goods and chattles of the affd Benjamin when ever the same shall come to the hands of the affd Capel to be Administred on and because the affd John denys not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true prayes Judg'mt for those damages above confess'd together with his costs and charges affd to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore by consent of the parties affd it is considered that the affd John Tunstall recover against the affd Capel King Executor of the same Benjamin King his damages affd to the affd twelve pounds Eleven Shillings & Ten pence curr. money of Maryland in sum affd Confessed as also Two hundred and thirty pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges affd to the same John by the Court here and consent of the parties affd adjudged of the goods and chattles white
