Whereas Maj<sup>r</sup> George Dashiell hath an negro man named Tom that is ancient and Infirm &c whereupon at the prayer of the said George Dashiell he is discharged from paying of taxes for the said negro as afo is praid &c

Whereas Christopher Piper has an negro woman named Dido that is ailing and unwell &c. Whereupon at the prayer of the said Christopher Piper he is discharged from paying of taxes for the afo negro. untill please God to restore her to her health that she is able to Labour againe &c.

Whereas Mr. Robert King has an negro man named Toby that is Ancient and Infirm and past his Labour &c. Wherefore at the prayer of the said Robert King he is discharged from paying of taxes for the afo negro Toby as afo is praid &c
