The petition aforesaid being read and heard and mature deliberation whereupon had wherefore it is considered that the aforesaid Comfort Benton be discharged from paying of taxes for the aforesaid Negro woman named Bess for the future as by the petition aforesaid is prayed &c

being possessor of tract of land thoro which the County road runs which is prejudicial to your petitioner therefore your petitioner humbly prays your worship will be pleased to give your petitioner liberty to turn the same road not above two or three hundred yards all farthest out of the way your petitioner being willing to make the new road full as good as the old one having already got the consent of the overseer and people that clear the same Road your worship's compliance will cause your petitioner ever to pray — Sam<sup>e</sup> Mayo
