It is Comanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he take & said Sarah Ruc to the publick whipping post and there give her ten Lashes on the bare back well laid on untill the blood appear and then return her into Court &c. afterward in the same Court came the said Sheriff and made Return that he had done the Execution of the Judges order as to the Corporall punishment &c. he was Comanded Thereupon the said Sarah Ruc is ordered to give Security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due by Omission of the promises &c. but for want thereof the said Sarah Ruc is committed into the Custody of the said Sheriff there to remaine &c.

At which said third Tuesday of November to with the nineteenth day of the same month and said one thousand seven hundred and thirty four came here in Court as well the said John Beavins as the said Petitioner in their proper persons and the petition &c. being read and heard and the severall allegations &c. as well on the part of the said John Beavins as on the part of the petitioner being fully understood & mature deliberation thereupon being had ... Wherefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the said John Beavins keep the orphans &c. and that he putt them to school by much need, otherwise if there is any further Complaint on behalf of the orphans &c. against him that's materials the orphans shall be removed to some friend or person or persons that will take care of them &c.
