Adm^d. for the whole and in the whole jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our Seals and dated this 22^d day of November anno Domⁱ 1734 —

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Commissary General hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the Estate of Stephen Coston dec^d. wherein it is found that there is Bald^d due to the aforesd orphans the sum of fifty six pounds fourteen Shillings and three pence three farthings if therefore the aforesd comfort Benton Isaac Coston and Richard Chambers or any or either of them or any or either of their heirs Ex^d. or Adm^d. do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the aforesd orphans the aforesd sum of fifty six pounds fourteen Shillings and three pence three farthings in equal parts or portions according to act of assembly when they shall arrive at full age to receive the same & then the above obligation to be void & of none effect otherwise to remain in full force.
