Thereupon Command was given to the sheriffs of Somerset County that he should take the said John Elzey if &c. to answer &c. and afterwards to wit the nineteenth day of November and Dom one thousand Seven hundred and thirty four before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here held at Diving Creek Cometh the said John Elzey in his proper person according to a certain Recognizance by him and his pledges in that part before acknowledges and had a hearing of the Information afo. and being Instantly demanded how he would acquitt himself of the premises afo. by the Information afo. above upon him Imposed says ^{that} of the premises afo. above upon him Imposed he is Guilty thereof &c. Whereupon all and singular the premises here being seen heard and fully understood &c.
