

One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came againe as well the said James as the said Heber by their attorneys
 and thorough the same Heber as before defend, the force and injury when & as to forty five shillings Sterling
 charged in the amount of the said James viz. Twenty two shillings and Six pence Sterling for Liberty of the Cabin
 to Liver pool, and twenty two shillings and Six pence for passage and Liberty of the Cabin from Cork to Maryland
 being of the Value of three pounds Curr Money of Maryland in the said James his Account
 charged he saith that he did not assume upon himself in Manner and form as the said
 James above in his Declaration aforesaid hath Alleged and of this he swears himself
 upon the Country & And the p^{ty} in Likemanner and as to one pound four shillings
 and Eight pence half penny residue of the Debt in the said Declaration mentioned the
 said Heber saith that the aforesaid James his Accⁿ aforesaid against him the said Heber
 thereupon to have and Maintain ought not because he saith that altho he the said Heber
 as to the aforesaid one pound four shillings and Eight pence half penny he did assume
 upon himself as the said p^{ty} above in his Declaration Alleged Nevertheless the said
 Heber saith that since his Assumption aforesaid so aforesaid supposed to be made
 he hath an Accⁿ of his own for sundry properly chargeable in Acc^t which hath accrued
 due to the said Heber from the said James and if at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction
 of this Court amounting to the sum of three pounds and six pence Curr Money of Maryland
 as by Account herunto annexed may appear which he prays he may be admitted to discount
 against the Debt of the aforesaid James due by the said Heber amounting to one pound four
 shillings and Eight pence half penny aforesaid according to the form of the Act of Assembly
 in that behalf lately made and provided and this he is ready to verify wherefore the said Heber
 prays Judgment and that the aforesaid James from having his Accⁿ aforesaid thereupon
 against him the said Heber may be barred &c.
