Whereupon all and Singular the premises being seen heard and fully understood It is Considered by the Court here that the said William Kenney pay unto his Lordship the Lord proprietary for his fine by the Court here upon him Imposed for and by occasion of the premises &c whereof in full he is Convinced One hundred pounds of Tobacco & that the same William Kenney be taken to Satisfie his said Lordship of the fine &c &c Thereupon the said William Kenney is ordered to give Security for payment of the severall Officers their fees due by occasion of the premises &c but for want thereof the said William Kenney is committed into the Custody of the Sheriff of the County &c here to remaine &c

The Jurors for the right honourable the Lord proprietary Mary Truman. that now is for the body of Somerset County aforesaid upon their Oath do present that Mary Truman late of Coventry Parish in the County aforesaid Widow the sixteenth day of October in the year of our Lord God seventeen hundred thirty four with force and arms at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court the lid of one silver tankard of the value of three pounds current money of Maryland of the goods and Chattles of M^r. Mary Hampton then and there being found then and there feloniously did steal take and bear away contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government and against the force of the act of Assembly in such case lately made and provided &c

Whereupon came here into Court the said Mary Truman ^{under} Custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County into whose custody she was committed ^{before that time for the same} and being by the said Sheriff led to the bar is Instantly discharged from Custody as &c and is ordered to give Security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due by means of the premises &c Thereupon aforesaid Ralph Willm...
