Milburn and Robert Boyer both of the County of plunkers present here in Court acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary five pound Sterling each to be Levied on ^{his} Body's Goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements &c. If it happen that the said Mary Freeman doth not pay unto the severall Officers their fees due by Omission of the premises &c.

The petition of being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had wherefore It is considered by the Court here that the said Alice Hopkins becom home and repair to the said John Larrimore father of Thomas Larrimore decd. and to gain satisfaction of him for the Nursing ^{& maintaining} of two Children lately begott on the Body of her the said Alice by the said Thomas Larrimore decd. and if the said John Larrimore refuse or delayeth to make her such reasonable satisfaction as will be sufficient for the Nursing and maintaining of the said two Children, that then the said Alice Hopkins to go immediately to James Dashiell of Milb. Dashiell of Somerset County Gent. and two of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County afo. and acquaint them therewith; and that the said James Dashiell and Michell Dashiell be hereby required to agree with some person or persons for the Nursing and maintaining of the Children afo. and they to make their Report to next March Court &c.
