Milburn and Robert Boyer both of the County and planters present here in Court acknowledged themselves Indebted

It is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Alice Hopkins be sent home and repair to the aforesaid John Lannimore
father of Thomas Lannimore decd. and require satisfaction of him for the nursing of two children lately begot on
the body of the said Alice by the said Thomas Lannimore decd. and if the said John Lannimore refuseth or
desireth to make her such reasonable satisfaction as will be sufficient for the nursing and maintaining
of the aforesaid two children that then the said Alice Hopkins to go immediately to James Dashiell & Wilhel:
le Dashiell of Somerset County Gentle and two of his worshipfull Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid
and acquaint them therewith; and then the said James Dashiell and Wilhelme Dashiell are hereby required to agree
with some person or persons for the nursing and maintaining of the children aforesaid and they to make their
Report to next March Court.
