Hoppercraft

Therupon it is Comanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that Immediately and without delay he should summon the said Arthur Warwick Esq. so that all Expenses bet apart he be and appear here in Court to answer the petition aforesaid. after wards in the same Court came the said Sheriff and made return that he had summoned the said Arthur Warwick as aforesaid he was Comanded

Whereupon came heronits Court as well the said Arthur Warwick as the said Petitioner in their proper persons and the petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood and the several allegations as well on the part of the petitioner as on the part of the said Arthur Warwick being thorowly and maturely deliberated &c.

It is Considered that the said Arthur Warwick pay and deliver unto the said Tho. Hoppercraft all his Freedom dues that is allowed to such servants according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c.

His Lordship - Mary Tilley of Somerset County widdow came heronits Court in her proper person and gave the Sureties of the peace against Robert Daniell Kinnigan and makes oath according to Law &c. Whereupon

the said Daniel Kinnigan present heronits Court in his proper person is ordered to give Security for his good behaviour and appearance at next Court next &c.

Whereupon the said Daniel Kinnigan with Aaron Lynn of Somerset County Gent. his family both present heronits Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Dore propriety in ten pounds Sterling each of their goods and Chattell Lands and tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Successors to be made and Levied If it happen that the said Daniel Kinnigan do not make his personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at Swidning freake the third Wednesday of March next and do not answer
