of the act of Assembly in such case made and provided and prosecute the same appeal
with effect at the next provincial Court to be held for this province and also satisfy
and pay to the said John Meccuddy his Ex. Adm. or assigns in case the said Judgment
shall be affirmed as well all and singular the debts damages and costs adjudged by the
said County Court and from whose Judgment he hath appealed as also all costs and
damages that shall be awarded by the said provincial Court then the above Obligation
to be void Else to remain in full force and vertue
