safe keep so that he might have their bodies before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Widning Creek in the County of the third Wednesday of November then next to answer unto Herritt Ratchford of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c and that hereof he should not fail &c

And the said Herritt Ratchford by George Douglas his attorney complained against the said John Britt & Thomas Bellin's in the plea as followeth &c

Somerset sh^r John Britt and Thomas Bellin's late of Somerset County Gent^l were attached to answer unto Herritt Ratchford of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c

And whereupon the same Herritt Ratchford by Geo. Douglas his attorney complains that whereas the said John Britt and Thomas Bellin after the first day of May Ann^d Dom^o Seventeen hundred & five to wit on the third day of June Ann^d Dom^o Seventeen hundred & thirty three at Somerset County afores^d within the jurisdiction of this Court did make their certain note in writing called a promissary with their proper hands subscribed bearing date the day and year last mentioned and the same note to the said Herritt Ratchford then and there did deliver by which note the said John Britt & Thomas did promise to pay to the said Herritt Ratchford or his order the sum of Seven pounds Eleven Shillings & nine pence current money of Virginia at four months after the date of the said note for value of the said Herritt Received (which said sum of Seven pounds Eleven Shillings & nine pence current money of Virginia the said Herritt avers to be of the
