Value of eight pounds six shillings & eleven pence current money of Maryland by pretense
whereof & also by force of the Statute in that case made and provided the aforesaid John Britt
and Thomas Bellings became chargeable to pay to the said Heritt Patchford the aforesum
of seven pounds eleven shillings and nine pence of the value aforesaid according to the tenor of
the said note and being so thereof chargeable the aforesaid John Britt & Thomas Bellings on con-
sideration thereof afterward to wit on the third day of June anno Domini Seventeen
hundred & thirty three at the County aforesaid upon themselves did assume and to the said Heritt
Patchford then and there faithfully promise to pay to the said Heritt the aforesum of
money of the value aforesaid according to the tenor of the said note and altho the aforesaid John and
Thomas have paid to the said Heritt the sum of two pounds seven shillings and eight pence
half penny current money of Virginia of the value of two pounds twelve shillings & five
pence half penny current money of Maryland part of the said seven pounds eleven
shillings & nine pence current money of Virginia. Nevertheless as to five pounds four shillings
and a half penny current money of Virginia of the value of five pounds fourteen shillings
and five pence half penny current money of Maryland residue of the said seven pounds ele-
ven shillings & nine pence current money of Virginia the aforesaid John Britt & Thomas Bellings
their promise and assumption aforesaid in manner and form aforesaid made little regarding but
minding and fraudulently intending the aforesaid Heritt in that part craftily and subtilly to
deceive and defraud the aforesaid five pounds four shillings & one half penny current money
of Virginia of the value of five pounds fourteen shillings and five pence half penny
current money of Maryland residue of the said seven pounds eleven shillings & nine
pence current money of Virginia to the aforesaid Heritt at four months after the date of the said
note did not pay altho the same to doe by the said Heritt afterwards viz on the thirtieth
day of November in the year last mentioned at the County aforesaid the said John and Thomas
were required, but the same to him to pay have altogether refused and still doe refuse to
the damage of the said Heritt Patchford eleven pounds current money of Maryland and
thereof he brings suit & _____

Somerset County gent present here in Court in his proper person undertake for the said Heritt that in case
he be nonsuited in the pleading or otherwise Legally first that then the said Heritt shall pay the judgment
