that whereas the aff. Robert the twelfth day of September which was in the year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred and thirty at Somerset County aff. by his certain writing obligatory had granted himself to be bound unto the aff. John in the aff. sum of sixty two pounds six shillings current money of Maryland and Eleven hundred and thirty pounds of tobacco to be paid unto the same, when, <sup>John</sup> there of afterwards he should be required. Nevertheless, the aff. Robert altho' often required the aff. sum of money and Tobacco unto the aff. John hath not paid but that unto him hitherto to pay altogether hath refused and still doth refuse to the damages of the same John Sixty pounds current money and two thousand pounds of Tobacco and thereupon he brings Suit & doth bring herinto Court the writing obligatory aff. with the debt aff. in form aff. doth testify the date whereof is the same day and year aff. &: pledges &: John Doe & Rich. Roe

And the aforesaid Robert Dyas by William Goldborough his attorney Cometh & defendeth the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot gain say the action aff. of the aforesaid John Rider nor can he say but that the writing Obligatory aff. is the deed of the same Robert Dyas nor but that he owes the same John Rider the aforesaid sixty two pounds six shillings current money and Eleven hundred and thirty pounds of tobacco in manner and form as the aff. John above against him hath declared &c.

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid John Rider Resover against the aff. Robert Dyas his debt aff. and his damages by occasion of the detaining of the same debt to two hundred and thirty seven - - - pounds of tobacco to the same John Rider of his aff. by the Court here - adjudged and the aforesaid Robert in Mery &c. afterwards to with the nineteenth day of November and. Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four Cometh here in Court the aff. Robert Dyas in his presence person and upon him the same Robert is committed to the prison of the Sheriff of Somerset County by occasion of the premises that to remain until the said John of his debt and damages aff. should be there of fully satisfied &c. the said Sheriff to with Joseph M. Clerk Genl. present here in Court took charge of the said Robert Dyas accordingly. &c. - - -
