Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty third day of August In the twentieth year of our Dominion &c. And Domd One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four

At which said third Tuesday of November to with the Nineteen the day of the same month And Domd One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four Being the day of the return of the said Writ Cometh the said Jonathan Sturgis in his proper person and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed likewise comes and makes return thereof to the Court here Endorsed

Sum of three pounds three Shillings and four pence Court money so as afo. attached may be condemned in the hands of the said John Driggereff as of the Rights and Credits of the said Joseph Gabey to wards satisfying unto the said Jonathan Sturgis his Damages and all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the attachment afo. &c.
