And Whereupon the said James Dickerson by George Douglas his attorney says
that whereas the said Charles on the twenty ninth day of March A.D. 1734
Seventeen hundred & twenty six at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction
of this Court by his certain writing obligatory which the said James sealed
with the seal of the said Charles herewith into Court brings whose date
is the same day and year aforesaid did bind himself to pay to the said Nathaniel
Brittingham the quantity of fifty one cuts of good Cypress timber five foot
four Inches long Seven Eight nine & ten Inches broad & Each quarter to
afford Eight nine & ten boards at the said Brittinghams Landing by the
first day of October then next ensuing the date of the said writing obli-
gatory (which said quantity of Cypress timber) the aforesaid James Dickerson assignee
as aforesaid of the said Nathaniel avers to be of the value of twelve pounds
& fifteen Shillings current money of Maryland and whereas the aforesaid Nathaniel
afterwards viz. on the thirtieth day of September in the year aforesaid at the County
aforesaid within the aforesaid Jurisdiction by his certain writing of assignment on the
said writing obligatory Endors'd did assign to the said James all his Right
and title to the said writing obligatory (the aforesaid quantity of Cypress timber
