Whereas we whose names are here under written were appointed by the worshipfull the Justices of Somerset County Court by the Consent of James Dickerson assignee of Nathaniel Brittingham. Esq. and Charles Ramsey Defendant to determine all matters in difference between them according to the form of the Statute in that case lately made and provided and to make return of our award to the said Court do humbly certify to the said Court that we have duly examined the matter in difference between the said partyes and do award that the Plaintiff say all cost because we find no cause of action given under our hands and seals this 23. day of November 1734
