Ordered by the Court that Samuel Handy recover against Richard Gore and Jean his wife thirty pounds of Tobacco being due unto him for his attendance one day as an Evidence on behalf of his Lordship against the said Richard Gore and Jean his wife he having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered that Nicholas fountain and Miesam Waters be Overseers from the Beach and Line down the middle of the neck from Absalomford which Road is to be completed after the arrival of the people
