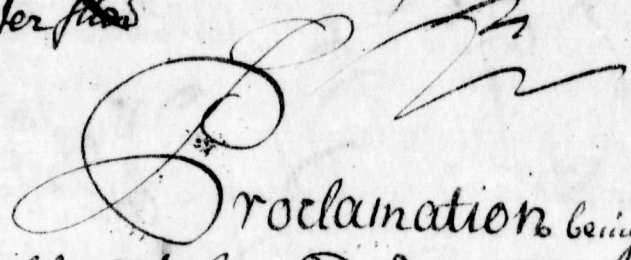

County to witt Joseph McCarter gent. made return of the pannell of Grand Jurors as followeth viz  
Robert Jones Thomas Bensch Michael Disharoon Stephen Hopkins Geo. Caron Joseph Gillin John Covington  
William Hickman Junr Cannon Winright John Magloughlin Lewis Disharoon Charles Tisdale William McClellan  
John Collins Broad Great George Howard John Forman Benjamin Holland Edward Franklin Nathl  
Crupper - whereupon Proclamation being made againe in usual form and the Jurors as so as aforesaid  
called being severally called over by their names did appear as above and thereupon they were sworn and  
charged and sent out to consider &c. soon after the Jurors as being impannelled sworn and charged as aforesaid  
return here into Court and being severally called over did appear and return the following Judgments against  
Stephen Lank, Edward Condon Hannah Blake and John Robins thereupon the grand Jurors are  
discharged and ordered that they be allowed five hundred pounds of tobacco for their publick service this  
Court and against the aforesaid Stephen Lank, Edward Condon Hannah Blake and John Robins so as aforesaid  
Judged it is ordered that Lapis & fine returnable to June Court next &c
