Jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornication with a certain Francis Williams and other body then
and there had carnal knowledge and abastard child on the body of her the same Francis then and there
did begot to the high displeasure of almighty God to the said Example of all others in such case offend-
ing Contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and government and
against the form of the act of assembly in such case lately made and provided aforesaid.

To the said Francis Williams - On the back side of the foregoing Bill of Indictment it was endorsed
vid. Thomas Humphrys foreman.

Thereupon command was given to the sheriff
of Somerset County that he should take the said Geo: Bowen if he be to answer, and afterward to will the
eighteenth day of March anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and thirty four before the Justice of his Lord-
ship's County Court of Somerset now here hold at Bridgwater in the same County the said George Bowen in
his proper person according to a certain recognizance by him and his security before that time acknowledged
and had a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid and thereupon he is instantaneously demanded how he would
acquaint himself of the premises aforesaid above upon him imposed; says that he is guilty there-
of and is willing to pay his fine for the fact aforesaid.

Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood
It is considered by the Court here that the said George Bowen pay unto his Lordship the sum propter
for his fine by the Court here upon him imposed for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid whereof inform
and he is bound thirty shillings current money for the use of the County aforesaid and that the said George
Bowen be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid whereupon the said Geo: Bowen is or-
dered to give security for the payment of the several Officers their fees due by means of the premises aforesaid.

Whereupon a certain Edward Rownd of Somerset County Gentleman present herein Court in his proper person
acknowledged himself indebted in five pounds sterling to be levied aforesaid if it happen that he doth not
pay unto the several Officers their fees due upon the Indictment aforesaid against the said Geo: Bowen.

appearance at this Court and thereupon the said Daniel Kinnigan and his security is accordingly discharged
