by Occasion of the Premises on the Indictment aforesaid Thereupon a certain Mitchell  
Dashfield of Somerset County Gent: present herein Court undertakes for the  
said Francis Johnson to pay the Severall Officers their fees due on the  
Indictment as aforesaid: — Whereupon the said Francis Johnson is ordered  
to give Security for to save and keep harmless as well the Justice of Somerset  
County Court and their Successors for the time being as also the Inhabitants  
of the said County of and from all Costs Charges and trouble whatsoever for  
or by reason of the birth maintainance nourishing and bringing up of  
the bastard Child aforesaid: — Thereupon a certain Jannet Wharwright  
and John Murrow of Somerset County planters present herein Court under-  
took for the said Francis Johnson and acknowledged themselves Indebted  
unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in twenty pounds Sterling Each  
of their goods and Chattels Lands or tenement to the use of the Justice  
of the County aforesaid and their Successors for the time being jointly and  
Severally to be made and Levied — If it happen that the said Francis  
Johnson her heirs Executors Administrators any of them do not from time  
to time and at all times hereafter acquit discharge and Save harmless  
as well the Justice of the County aforesaid and their Successors for the time  
being as also the Inhabitants of said County of and from all Costs Charges  
and trouble whatsoever by reason of the birth maintainance nourishing  
and bringing up of the aforesaid Bastard Child and of and from all other  
suits Charges troubles and demands whatsoever touching or concerning the same  
aforesaid

His Lordship } Somerset County: The Jurors for the Right Honourable the  
Michael Dorman } Lord Proprietary that now is for the Body of Somerset County  
aforesaid upon their Oath do present that Michael Dorman late  
of Somerset Parish in the County aforesaid planter the first day  
of January in the year of our Lord God Seventeen Hundred thirty and four with  
force and arms aforesaid at the Parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction  
of this Court one unmarked Hog of the Value of one hundred pounds of Tobacco  
then and there being above three months old and not on the land of the aforesaid  
Michael Dorman then being and then and there not being in Company with  
the Stock of the said Michael Dorman of the goods and Chattels of a person  
to the Jurors aforesaid unknown then and there being found then and there feloniously  
did kill contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good  
Rule and Government and against the form of the act of assembly in such
