The Court here endorsed in these words following vid. Legi Veritas declaration delivered in time of
Jor: M. Gester Jor: S.

Whereupon the said William West in his own proper person comes and defends the force and Injury
wherein &c. and thereupon the said William West at the prayer of the plaintiff by his attorney &c. is adjudged
by the Court here to give special Bail to the action &c. but for want thereof the said William West is
committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County here to remain &c. the said Sheriff to wait for
Mr. Gester Jor: S. present took charge of the said William West accordingly &c.

Whereupon the said Joshua Caldwell prays that the said William West to his declaration &c. may answer
upon this the same William hath day unto him give by the Court here on the Thursday the fourth day of
the term here to answer &c. and the same William at the same day solemnly called to answer someth not
nor says nothing in bar or preclusion of the action &c. of the said Joshua by which the same Joshua
is indebted against the same William three of hundred -- wherefore the same Joshua by damages by
occasion of the premises against the said William West ought to recover and have &c. whereupon at the
prayer of the said Joshua and by the consent of the same William the Justice here according to act of
assembly in such case made and provided assessed the damages of the same Joshua by occasion of the
non performance of the promise and assumption &c. beyond his costs and charges by him about his
suit in that part assessed to eighteen hundred sixty three and a half pounds ---

Therefore it is considered that the said Joshua Caldwell recover against the said William
West his damages &c. to eighteen hundred sixty three and a half pounds by the Justice &c.
306: in form &c. assessed as also three hundred and six --- pounds of tobacco
for his costs and charges to the same Joshua by the Court here of his assent adjudged and the said defendant
in mercy &c.

the Sher. of Somerset County greeting we command you that you attach any of the
goods Chattels rights or Credits of William Wye Esq. if they shall be found in your
bailiwick to the value of thirty Eight pounds Eighteen Shillings and three pence
Ster. and one thousand pound of Tobacco and when you have the same attached on
any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before
our Justice of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Owiding Creek the third
Tuesday of March next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly
to satisfy George Eskridge of thirty Eight pounds Eighteen Shillings & three pence
(Sterling)
