Sterling and three hundred & Eighty two pounds of tobacco &c. and that by  
good and lawfull men of your bailiwick you make known unto the person  
or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he, she, or they  
be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause  
if any he, she, or they have why the same goods Chattels Rights or Credits so  
attached in his, her, or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof  
had and made according to act of assembly in such case made and provided if to  
him, her, or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this writt that  
you make <sup>known</sup> unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and  
there this writt Witness Robert King Gent. Chief Justice of our Co. Court the  
Twenty fifth day of November In the twentieth Year of our Dominion &c. and Dom.  
One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four — All which said third Tuesday  
of March to wit the Eighteenth day of the same month and Dom. One thousand  
Seven hundred and thirty four being the day of the return of the said writt cometh  
the said George Eskridge by William Bechingham his attorney and the Sheriff  
of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed likewise comes and  
makes return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following viz<sup>t</sup>  
To the worshipfull Justices within mentioned I certify that on the twenty fifth  
day of January in the year Seventeen hundred & thirty four at Somerset County  
before Thomas Walker & John Doe good and lawfull men of my bailiwick I  
attached Eight thousand one hundred ninety four & an half pounds of tobacco  
and one thousand pounds of Tobacco in my own hands as of the goods & Chattels  
of the same William Wye which same said sum of tobacco by Thomas Walker  
George Dashiell Thomas Gillis and Alexander Lechie Officer holder of the County  
aforesaid duly summoned & sworn is by them appraised at the rate of nine shilling  
and four pence half penny Sterling off. Hundred as by a Schedule thereof hereunto  
annexed may appear — so answer — Jos: Macclister Sheriff —

Whereupon the aforesaid Joseph Macclister Garnishee of the aforesaid William Wye appears in his own  
proper person and says that he cannot Garnishee but that he has of the rights and Credits of the  
William Wyes to the value of Eight thousand One hundred ninety four and a half pounds of Noble  
valued as aforesaid at Nine shillings and four pence half penny Sterling hundred and One thousand  
pounds of tobacco <sup>more</sup> so as aforesaid attached nor can he say but that the same ought to be condemned  
in his hands for the use of the said Geo. Eskridge as of the rights and Credits of the same Wm.  
Wye which the same Justices doth not Garnishee &c.

Thereupon the said Geo. Eskridge by his attorney aforesaid pray that upon giving security accord-  
ing to act of assembly in such case provided that the aforesaid Nine thousand One hundred ninety four  
and
