and a half pounds of tobacco so as aforesaid attached and confessed by the aforesaid Joseph W. Gester as of the rights and credits of the said William Wye may be condemned in the hands of the said Jor. W. Gester towards satisfying unto the said George Eskridge as well the sum of thirty eight pounds eighteen shillings and three pence sterling as three hundred and eighty two pounds of tobacco as also all costs accruing on the writ of attachment aforesaid &c.

Whereupon a certain William Buckingham of Somerset County Gent. present here in Court in his proper person undertook for the said George Eskridge according to act of assembly in such case made and provided that in case the said William Wye do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said George Eskridges claim against him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the laying of this attachment that then the said George Eskridge shall make restitution unto him the said Wm. Wye of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue &c. or that he the said William Buckingham will do the same for him &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid sum of nine thousand one hundred ninety four and a half pounds of tobacco so as aforesaid attached and confessed be condemned in the hands of the said Joseph W. Gester as of the rights and credits of the said William Wye towards satisfying unto the said George Eskridge as well the sum of thirty eight pounds eighteen shillings and three pence sterling and three hundred and eighty two pounds of tobacco as also all costs accruing upon the writ of attachment aforesaid and that the said Geo. Eskridge have thereof restitution according to act of assembly &c.

viz. Sir Somerset J. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the province of Maryland and absolute Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting
we command you that you attach any of the goods Chatters rights or credits of William Wye Esq. if they shall be found in your bailiwick to the value of Eleven pounds Sixteen shillings and six pence current money of Maryland & Eight hundred pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justice of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing week the third Tuesday of March next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to satisfy George Eskridge of Eleven pounds sixteen shillings and six pence current money of Maryland & two hundred and forty nine pounds of tobacco &c. and that by good and lawfull men of your bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justice of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause - (if
