attach any of the goods Chattles rights or Credits of William Booth late of Somerset
County planter if they shall be found in your bailiwick to the value of two thousand Eight
hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the
same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our
County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March Next
then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of a certain
John Dennis Junr. unless the said W^m Booth by himself or his attorney shall appear
and answer unto the said John Dennis Junr. in a plea of trespass upon the case &
according to law and that by good and lawfull men of your bailiwick you make known
