Plattell aforesaid attached as the proper goods and chattels of the aforesaid William Booth to the value of two
thousand Eight hundred and forty pounds of tobacco be condemned towards satisfying unto the said John
Dennis Plaintiff his damages and all costs and charges incurred by reason of the writ of attachment aforesaid
and that the said John Dennis Plaintiff have hold of his judgment according to act of assembly &c.

Command was given to the sheriff of Somerset County that he should take
Thomas Riley late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailie wick
and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships by
Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of June next to answer unto unto Rob.
Bolton of aglee of the paf upon his case and that time of his should not fail &c.

And the said Robert Bolton by Francis Allen his attorney Complains against the said Thomas Riley
in the place aforesaid followeth out —

Somerset County p. Thomas Riley late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto
Robert Bolton of aglee of the paf upon his case &c

And Whereupon the said Robert by Francis Allen his attorney Complains that whereas
the said Thomas the tenth day of November anno Domini seventeen hundred and thirty two at
the County of Somerset aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was Indebted unto the sd Robert
in Seven pounds ffive shillings and ffive pence curr. money of Maryland a by acc^t. here:
unto annexed and herein Court produced may appear and being so thereof Indebted the said
Thomas in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesd. at the place
afored. upon himself did assume and to the said Robert then & there did faithfully promise —
that he the sd Thomas the sd Seven pounds ffive shillings & ffive pence to the sd Robert
which he should be thereunto requested well & faithfully he would pay & Content and altho'
the sd Thomas one pound Seven shillings and ten pence ffewell of the aforesd. seven pounds ffive
shillings & ffive pence to the sd Robert he hath paid and satisfied yett as to ffive pounds
Seventeen Shillings & Seven pence residue of the aforesd. Seven pounds ffive shillings and
ffive pence the sd Thomas his promise & assumption aforesd. in forme aforesd. made nothing
regarding but plotting & fraudulently intending the sd Robert in that part craftily and
subtilly to deceive and defraud the sd ffive pounds Seventeen Shillings and Seven pence to the said
Robert altho' the same to do the sd Thomas by the sd Robert on the aforesd tenth Day
