Whereupon the said Thomas Riley in his proper person cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot gainsay the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Robert Bolton nor can he say but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid Robert Bolton above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same Robert Bolton by him by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to ffive pounds Seventeen shillings and Seven pence current money of Maryland and not more, and because the aforesaid Robert denies not this but the same Allegation Confesseth to be true prays Judgment for those damages above Confessed together with his costs and charges aforesaid to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by consent of the parties aforesaid it is considered that the aforesaid Robert Bolton recover against the aforesaid Thomas Riley his damages aforesaid to the aforesaid ffive pounds Seventeen Shillings and Seven pence current money of Maryland in form aforesaid. Confessed
