Whereupon the said Donnick Dennis in his own proper person Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot gain say the action of the said Robert Bolton nor can he say but that he did of some upon himself in manner and form as the said Robert Bolton above against him hath Complain'd and as to the Damage of the same Robert by him by Occasion of the premises in that part shew'd the same Donnick saith and Confesseth that the said Robert hath sustained Damages by Occasion of the premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part apposed to three pounds two shillings and one penny Curr. money of many kind and not more and because the said Robert deny's not this but the same allegation Confesseth to be true pray's Judgment for those Damages above Complain'd together with his Costs and Charges aforesaid to himself and god &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties and it is Considered that the said Robert Bolton recover of the said Donnick Dennis his Damages of to the said three pounds two shillings and one penny Curr. money of many kind in form as Complain'd as also two hundred & Sixty two pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges to the same Robert by the Court here and Consent of the parties and as Judged and the said Defendant in mercy &c.
