to give speciall bail to his action aforesaid Thereupon a certain Mathew Dorman and Henry Toadore of  
Somerset County planters both present here in Court in their proper persons undertook and each of  
them undertook and affirmed upon themselves for the said Thomas Holbrook (likewise the said Thos.  
Holbrook present here in Court as aforesaid affirmed upon himself) that if in case the said Joshua Caldwell  
shall recover judgment in the plea aforesaid against the said Thomas Holbrook or that the said Thos.  
should be known Convict that then he the said Thos Holbrook  
Holbrook shall pay his Indemnition of the Court Thereupon or tender his body for Execution of  
such Judgment to the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that they the said Mathew -  
Dorman and Henry Toadore or each of them will do the same for him etc.

Whereupon the said Thomas Holbrook by William Goldsborough his attorney Cometh and defendant  
the fore and injury when &c and saith that he did not assume upon himself in such manner &  
form as the afo<sup>r</sup> Joshua above against him hath declared and of this he doth putt himself upon the found  
re and the p<sup>r</sup> in like manner - - - Whereupon the said Thomas by his attorney afo<sup>r</sup> relinquish  
eth his Verification afo<sup>r</sup> by him above alledged and the same attorney of the same Thomas saith that  
he is not Informed by the same Thomas his C<sup>r</sup>yant of any answer for the same Thomas to the afo<sup>r</sup>  
Joshua to be given and nothing else than of Faith by whil<sup>t</sup> the same Joshua remains against the said  
Thomas therof undefended &c. Wherefore the same Joshua his damages by occasion of  
the premises against the afo<sup>r</sup> Thomas Holbrook ought to recover and have &c. Whereupon  
at the prayer of the afo<sup>r</sup> Joshua and by consent of the same Thomas the Justices here accor  
ding to act of assembly in such case made and provided afo<sup>r</sup> the damages of the same  
Joshua by occasion of the non performance of the promise and assumption afo<sup>r</sup> beyond his  
Costs and charges by him about his suit in that part appered to Eight hundred and twenty  
Eight pounds of Tobacco - - - Therefore it is considered that the afo<sup>r</sup> Joshua  
Caldwell recover against the afo<sup>r</sup> Thomas Holbrook his damages afo<sup>r</sup> to Eight hundred and  
twenty Eight pounds of Tobacco by the Justices afo<sup>r</sup> in form afo<sup>r</sup> afo<sup>r</sup> as also five  
hundred and twelve - - - pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges to the  
same Joshua by the Court here of his afo<sup>r</sup> adjudged and the afo<sup>r</sup> defendant in mercy & -
