Whereupon the dispute in this action is by the Court and Consent of the parties aforesaid referred to Henry Ballard and Thomas Gillis of Somerset County Gent. according to the form of the Statute and that they returne their award in the premises in writing from under their Hand, to the Court here immediately in order that Judgment may be given thereon as of this Court &c.

And afterwards to witt the same day and year came here into Court the same Henry Ballard & Thomas Gillis the persons mentioned in the rule of reference and made return of their award in the premises as followeth vid. Whereas the Court now sitting hath appointed us the Subscribers to decide a Cause Between M<sup>r</sup> Joshua Colewell plaintiff and John Follows defend. and upon perusal of their accounts we do find that there is due to the plaintiff Eight hundred and Sixty pounds of Tobacco .. which being read and heard. It is Therefore considered by the Court here that the said Joshua Colewell recover against the said John Follows his damages as to the said Eight hundred and Sixty pounds of Tobacco by the said arbitrators in form aforesaid as also three hundred & Twenty four .. 324 .. pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges to the same Joshua by the Court here and Consent of the parties as adjudged and the said defend. in mercy &c.

And the said Edward Rownd by Robert Tenchins Henry <sup>his attorney</sup> complained against the said John Bishop Junr. in the plea aforesaid as followeth vid. Somerset County John Bishop Junr. late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto Edward Rownd of a plea of trespass upon the case &c.  
And whereupon the said Edward by Robert Tenchins Henry his attorney complaineth that whereas the aforesaid John the nineteenth day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred thirty and four at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the said Edward in twenty five pounds one Shilling and four pence halfe penny current Money of Maryland as by Acc<sup>t</sup> hereunto annexed may in Court appear and being so thereof indebted the said John the day and year aforesaid at the place aforesaid in consideration thereof upon himself did assume and to the said Edward then and there did faithfully promise that he the said John the aforesaid twenty five pounds
