here to with the thirteenth day of November last: Found: One thousand seven hundred and twenty eight
before the worshipfull Samuel Hopkins Gent. and his associates the three Justices of our said Court at divid-
ing Creek in the County afo. by consideration of the same Court recovered against Elizabeth Dashiell
late of Somerset County widow Administratrix of all and singular the goods and Chattels rights
and Credits which were of Christopher Dashiell at the time of his death twenty eight pounds One
Shilling and three pence three farthings (to be paid as followeth Six thousand Merchantable pipe
Staves at fifty five Shillings of Tobacco and the remainder of the afo. Twenty eight pounds One
Shilling and three pence three farthings to be paid in Corn and pork at County price) and four
hundred and thirty nine pounds of Tobacco for his damages which he sustained as well by occasion
of the Non performance of a certain promise and subscription to the same Adam by the afo. Christo-
pher in his Lifetime made as for his costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appeared
to be levied of the goods and Chattels which were of the afo. Christopher Dashiell in the hands
of the afo. Elizabeth to be administered if so much in her hand she hath and if so much
