 George Martin - Somerset County
 William Wye Junr. Mariner was attached to answer unto George Martin
 of a plea of Troppas upon the Case.

And Whereupon the said George by Francis Allon his Attorney sheweth
 that Whereas the said William the Twentieth day of Jan^r Anno Domini 1733
 hundred and thirty one at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court
 was Judged unto the said George in the Sum of twelve pounds three Shillings
 and seven pence Curr^t money of Maryland it being as well for sundry goods
 wares and Merchandises by the said George to the said William at the
 special Instance and Request of the said William before that time there
 sold and Delivered as for sundry other things properly chargeable in account
 as by Acc^t therunto annexed may in Court appear and being so thereof
 Judged the said William in Consideration thereof the Day and Year aforesaid
 at the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid Upon himself did Assume and to the
 said George then and there did faithfully promise that he the said William
 the aforesaid twelve pounds three Shillings and seven pence to the said George
 when he should be therunto Requested he would well and faithfully pay
 and Content and altho the said William three pounds eight Shillings and
 six pence half penny part of the aforesaid twelve pounds three Shillings
 and seven pence to the said George he hath paid and Satisfied yet as to
 eight pound fifteen Shillings and one half penny Residue of the aforesaid
 twelve pounds three Shillings and seven pence the said William his
 promise and Assumption aforesaid in form aforesaid made Nothing regarding
 but plotting and fraudulently Intending of the said George in that part Craftily
 and Subtly to Deceive and Defraud the aforesaid eight pound fifteen Shillings
 and one half penny to the said George altho the same to be the said William
 by the said George on the aforesaid Twentieth Day of January in the Year
 aforesaid and Often afterwards at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid
 he was therunto Requested hath not paid or Contented but the same to him
 hitherto pay or Content hath Refused and still doth Refuse and Delay where
 upon the said George saith he is worse and hath Damage to the Value of Eight
 pound Curr^t money of Maryland aforesaid. And thereupon he brings in
 a Bill of Complaint against the said William.
