We Command you that by honest and Lawfull Men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the said James Shirley that he be and Appear before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next to show Cause if any thing for himself he hath or to say knoweth wherefore the aforesaid Sarah Stewart her Execution against him of the Judgment aforesaid to have ought not according to the form of the Recovery aforesaid if to him it seemeth Expedient and have you then and there the Names of those before whom to him you make the same known and this Writt Witness Rob<sup>t</sup>. King Gent. Chief Justice our said Court the twenty second Day of March in the Eighteenth Year of our Dominion G<sup>ra</sup>. Anno Dom<sup>ini</sup>; one thousand Seven hundred and thirty two
