Saith that Whereas he the aforesaid Robt. Lately to witt at a County Court of the Right Honourable the Lord Prop^{ty} of this Province held at Dividing Brook in the County of Somerset in and for the said County of Somerset the third Tuesday in Novemb^r. Anno Domⁱ Seventeen hundred and thirty by the Consideration of the said Court Recovered Against a certain James Rowland Seventeen pounds twelve Shillings and five pence Curr^t Money of Maryland and four hundred twenty and five pounds of Tob^o. it being as well for his Damages Occasioned by Reason of the Non performance of a certain promise and assumption by the aforesaid James to the said Robt. before that time Made as for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that behalf Expended whereof he the said James was Convicted as by the Record thereof in the said Court more fully Appears And Whereas also afterwards to witt at the County Court aforesaid hold for the said County the aforesaid third Tuesday in November in the Year aforesaid the aforesaid Robt. by Francis Allen his Attorney before the Worshipfull the Justices of the County Court aforesaid and the aforesaid James Rowland in his proper person ^{though present} being present in the said Court at the Request of the said Francis Allen on the Behalf of the said Robt. was Committed by the said Court to John Purnell Esq^r High Sher^{iff} of the said County of Somerset and Keeper of the Prison of the said County of Somerset then being present in Court in Execution for the Damages and Costs aforesaid in the Custody of him the said Sher^{iff} to Remain and be safe kept until the said Robt. of the Damages and Costs aforesaid should be Satisfied By Virtue whereof the said John Purnell then Sher^{iff} of the County of Somerset aforesaid being the said James Under his Custody in Execution for the Damages and Costs aforesaid in the Prison of the Right Honourable the Lord Prop^{ty} at Dividing Brook in the County of Somerset aforesaid had and kept and the said James so being under the Custody of the said John Purnell then Sher^{iff} of Somerset County aforesaid in Execution for the Damages and Costs aforesaid In form aforesaid. the said John Purnell the fifteenth Day of July Anno Domⁱ Seventeen hundred and thirty one then being Sher^{iff} of the said County of Somerset and keeper of the Prison of the said County at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court Suffered the said James Rowland to go freely at Large whenever he would the said Robt. not being Satisfied of the Damages and Costs aforesaid in the whole Amounting Seventeen pounds twelve Shillings ^{five pence} Curr^t Money of Maryland and four hundred twenty and five pounds of Tob^o. whereby Accoon^t Accorded to the said Robt. to Demand and have of the said John Purnell the said Seventeen pounds twelve Shill^{ings} and five pence and four hundred and twenty five pounds of Tob^o for his Damages and Costs aforesaid by him the said Robt.
