pounds of tobacco in form as the same James by his will of Surefiance afo above Supposed, nor but that
the same James Escheweth of the afo twenty five thousand seven hundred pounds of tobacco according to
the form of the Recovery afo against him to have ought ther^e —

Therefore it is Considered that the afo James Donelson have Execution against the afo Heber -
Whittingham of the afo Twenty five Thousand Seven hundred pounds of tobacco his Damages afo Likewise
the afo James Donelson according to the form of the Statute in Such Case Lately made and provided
Recover against the afo Heber three hundred and forty six — — — pounds of tobacco for
his Costs and Charges sustained by Reason of delay of Execution of the Damages afo ther^e —
