 James Shirley Gou^t one of the Attorneys of the County Court of the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^r
 here present in Court in his proper person of a plea of Trespass upon the Case and the Tenor
 of which bill follows in these words viz^t To the Justices of the County Court of the Right
 Honourable the Lord Prop^r here now hold for the County of Somerset. Robt Watton by
 Francis Allon his Attorney Complains of James Shirley one of the Attorneys of the County
 Court of the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^r present here in Court in his proper person of a plea
 of Trespass upon the Case for that whereas the said James the sixteenth day of June
 Seventeen hundred and thirty one at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was
 indebted unto the said Robt^r in four pounds Cash and Eight pounds to be paid in Tob^o at Twelve
 Shillings and Six pence of hundred as by a certain Note ready here in Court to be produced by
 the said James signed dated the day and year aforesaid may appear and beinge thereof
 indebted the said James in and by the said Note in consideration thereof the Day and year
 aforesaid upon himself did assume and to the said Robert then and there did faithfully promise
 that he the said James the aforesaid four pounds in Cash and the aforesaid Eight pounds in Tob^o at
 Twelve Shillings and Six pence of hundred on the fourth day of April next ensuing the
 date of the said Note to the said Robt^r he would well and faithfully pay and content
 Nevertheless the said James his promise and assumption aforesaid made nothing
 regarding but plotting and fraudulently intending the said Robt^r in that part craftily
 and subtly to Deceive and Defraud the Ofter therunto Requested the said four pound
 in Cash nor the aforesaid Eight pounds in Tob^o at Twelve Shillings and six pence of
 hundred to the aforesaid Robt upon the aforesaid fourth day of April nor at any time since
 hath not paid or contented but the said Robt^r hath to him both to pay or content both Refused
 and still doth Refuse and Deny whereupon the said Robt^r hath his worse and
 hath Damage to the Value of Twenty four pounds Curr^t money of Maryland and
 thereupon he brings Suite and
 Pledges depl^y In Doe
 R. Roe

And the said James Shirley by William Buckingham his Attorney comes and
 defends the force and Injury when it is and prays leave thereof to Jurysale here untill
 next Court and he hath it and the same Day is given to the aforesaid Robt^r here also.
 At which said next Court to wit the twentieth day of March Anno Dom^o one
 thousand seven hundred and thirty two came again as well the aforesaid Robt Watton
 as the aforesaid James Shirley by their Attorneys aforesaid and thereupon the said James
 prays further leave thereof to Jurysale here untill next Court and he hath
 it and the same day is given the aforesaid Robt^r here also.
 At which said next Court to wit the thirtieth day of June Anno Dom^o
 one thousand seven hundred and thirty three came again as well the
 (aforesaid)
