And the said James shirly in his own proper person Comes and Defends the force and Injury when &c. and prays Leave thereof to Judge here, until next Court and he hath it and the same Day is Given to the aforesaid Rives here also &c.

At which said Next Court to witt the ~~twentieth~~ <sup>thirtieth</sup> day of June Anno Dom one thousand seven hundred and thirty two James again as well the aforesaid Rives Helt by his Attorney afo. as the aforesaid James Shirley in his proper person and thereupon the said James Shirley prays <sup>leave</sup> thereof to Judge here until the next Court and he hath it and the same Day is Given to the aforesaid Rives here also &c.

\* At which said Next Court to witt the Fifteenth Day of August Anno Dom one thousand seven hundred and thirty two James again as well the aforesaid Rives Helt by his Attorney afo. as the aforesaid James Shirley in his proper person and the said James Shirley as before ~~doth~~ <sup>doth</sup> Defends the force and Injury when &c. and prays a hearing of the Writing afo. as also of the Condition of the same Writing which being read and heard protesting that the bill afo. and the Matter in the same contained are altogether Insufficient in Law & to which he hath no Good or by the Law of the Land is in any sort held to Answer for plea he saith that the afo. Rives his Action afo. against him to have or Maintain ought not because he saith that he the said James after the Making the Writing afo. and before the Exhibition of the bill afo. to witt on the fiftieth day of September Anno Dom one thousand seven hundred and twenty eight at Somerset County afo. did pay and Satisfy unto the afo. Rives the Sum of five Shillings which same five Shillings the said Rives from the said James then and there recd in full Satisfaction
