George Collins aged about Twenty Six years being sworn on  
the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God before us above named concerning his  
knowledge of the Boundaries of Rogg Quarter and Common Garden deposes that  
followeth that about this time twelve Months this Deponent and John  
Richardson and John Nesham who is now Dead went down to the Marshes called  
Sandy Hill Marshes and that the said John Nesham showed him the said Collins  
a small Crook that Issues out of Colliers Crook and that the said Nesham told this  
Deponent that when the said Nesham was a boy he the said Nesham and his father  
used to go Down to that Crook a fishing and that the Crook used to be called fishing  
Crook, and further saith not

Charles Thompson aged about fifty three years who  
being sworn on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God touching his Knowledge  
of the boundaries of a Tract of Land called Rogg Quarter and another Tract  
called Common Garden before us James Duffield Rob. Collier and William Dashiell  
deposes that when this Deponent was about twelve or fourteen  
years old this Deponent and W<sup>m</sup> Chosman and a certain John Russell used to  
go a fishing in a small Crook issuing out of a small Crook known by the Name of  
Colliers Crook and that this Deponent heard the said Chosman and the said  
Russell say that old William Green told them that that Crook that Issues out  
of Colliers Crook was called fishing Crook and that further this Deponent  
saith about Six years past he heard old Roger Nicholson say that the Crook  
Issuing out of Colliers Crook used to be called fishing Crook formerly and that  
this Deponent about last Christmas heard a certain W<sup>m</sup> Layton of  
Dorset County say that formerly he used to fish in a Crook that Colliers  
Crook and that made one Mouth and that Colliers Crook made Down the  
River into the woods and the other made upwards into the Marshes  
and the said Layton told this Deponent that the Crook that made into the  
Marshes used to be called fishing Crook and further the Deponent Charles  
Thompson declares that the W<sup>m</sup> Chosman and John Russell were old Married  
Men at the time the said Thompson and Chosman and Russell used to fish  
in the said fishing Crook and that the said Russell then Lived about  
two Miles from ye said Crook on Dorset Side and the said Chosman about
