Prorog'd, Execution as yet Remaineth to be made as by the Insinuation of the aforesaid Sarah we have Received and because we will that those things which in our same Court were Rightfully Acted, ought to be Duly Executed, we Command you that by honest and Lawfull men of your Balgwick you make known unto the said James Shirley that he be and appear before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Crook the Third Tuesday of June Next to shew Cause if any thing for himself he hath or to say knoweth wherefore the aforesaid Sarah Stewart her Execution against him of the Judgment aforesaid to have ought not according to the form of the Recovery aforesaid, if to him it seemeth Expedient and have you there the Names of those before whom to him you make this Writ known Witness — Rob^t King Gent^l Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty second day of March in the Eighteenth year of our said W. Anno Dom^o 1733.

At which said Third Tuesday of June (to wit the Nineteenth Day of the same Month Anno Dom^o one thousand seven hundred and thirty three) before the Justices of his Lord^{sh} County Court of Somerset hold at Dividing Crook in the County aforesaid (and the aforesaid Sarah Stewart Dem^t as aft^r by Francis Allen her Attorney and the Sher^{iff} of Somerset County to wit Joshua Caldwell Gent^l at the same Day Returned that he by Virtue of the writ aforesaid to him Directed had made known unto the aft^r James Shirley by Joshua Morrill and David Polk honest and Lawfull men of his Balgwick that he be and appear before his said Lordships Justices at the Day and place aforesaid to shew C^{au}s^e as within to him it was Command^d and the aforesaid James Shirley so forewarned and at the same Day being solemnly Called Cometh not but makes Default —

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Sarah Stewart Dem^t of the same John Stewart have Execution against the same James Shirley of the ~~same~~ Damages aft^r according to the force form and Effect of the Recovery aft^r.

if he should be found in his Balgwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justices of his Lord^{sh} County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Crook the Third Tuesday of June then Next to Answer unto Rob^t Bolton of a Plea of Trespass upon the Case —
