Pondred Execution as yet remaineth to be made as by the Indimation of
the aforesaid Sarah we have Received and because we will that those things
which in our same Court were Rightfully tried, ought to be Duly Executed, we
Command you that by honest and Lawfull men of your Balywick you make
Known unto the Said James Shirley that he be and appear before our Justices
of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Crook the Third Tuesday
of June Next to shew cause if anything for himself hath or to say knoweth
wherefore the aforesaid Sarah Stewart her Execution Against him of the
Judgment aforesaid to have ought not according to the form of the Recovery
aforesaid, if to him it seemeth Expedient and have you then and therewith
Names of those before whom to him you make this Writt known Witness —
Robt King Esq: to Chief Justice of our Said Court the twenty second day of
March in the Eighteenth Year of our Lord & Anno Dom 1733.

At which said Third Tuesday of June (to wit) the Nineteenth Day
of the same Month Anno Dom one thousand Seven hundred and thirty three
before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset held at Dividing
Crook in the County aforesaid and the aforesaid Sarah Stewart Adm^t as aff'd.

Day and place aforesaid to them &c: as written to him it was commanded
and the aforesaid James Shirley so forewarned and at the same Day being solemnly
Called cometh not but makes Default —

of the same John Stewart have Execution against the same James
Shirley of the ~~Damages~~ Damages aff'd according to the form and effect
of the Recovery aforesd
