And whereupon the said William Whight by Rob^t Jenkins Henry his Attorney complains
:eth that Whereas the afd^r Patrick Connolly after the first Day of May in the Year of our Lord
God one thousand seven hundred and five (to witt) the Thirtieth day of June which was
in the Year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and thirty two at Somerset County within
the Jurisdiction of this Court did Draw his certain note in Writing called a Promissory note with
his proper hand subscribed bearing Date the said Day and year last mentioned and
that note unto the afd^r Rob^t Pitts then and there did Deliver by which same note the
said Patrick did promise to pay unto the said Rob^t one thousand pounds of good
Merchantable Pork by Reason thereof as also by force of the Statute in such case
lately made and provided the said Patrick became Lyable to pay unto the said Robert
the afd^r one thousand pounds of Pork according to the Tenor of the Note aforesaid and
so being Lyable the afd^r Patrick in Consideration thereof Afterward to witt the Tenth
day of July and year afd^r at Somerset County afd^r and within the Jurisdiction afd^r upon himself
did Assume and unto the said Rob^t then and there faithfully did promise to pay unto the
said Rob^t the afd^r one thousand pounds of Pork according to the Tenor of the Note afd^r
and the afd^r William further saith that the afd^r Rob^t after the Making of the Note afd^r
to witt on the Twelfth day of March one thousand seven hundred and thirty three at
Somerset County afd^r the afd^r one thousand pounds of Pork or any part thereof was
Satisfied as by his writing of Assignment from under the hand of the said Rob^t did Assign
and Make over unto the afd^r William White the note afd^r and the Pork therein
Mentioned whereof the said Patrick then and there had Notice by Reason whereof
and by force of the Act of Assembly in such case made and Provided Action Accrued
to the afd^r William to have and Require from the afd^r Patrick the afd^r one thousand
pounds of Pork Nevertheless the afd^r Patrick his promise and Assumption afd^r
not Regarding but Minding and fraudulently Intending the said Rob^t in this part
Craftily and Subtily to Deceive and Defraud the afd^r one thousand pounds of
Pork hath not paid altho the same by the said William Afterward to witt the
said Day and year last mentioned at Somerset County afd^r within the afd^r Jurisdiction
ye afd^r Patrick was Required but that unto him to pay altogether hath Refused
and still doth Refuse to the Damage of the said William of two thousand pounds
of like Pork and thereof he brings Suit &c.
