One hundred was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County Plat of the goods and Chattels of

Benj<sup>d</sup> Sharpe late of Somerset County Shipwright in his daily work he should make  
fifteen hundred and thirteen pounds of tobacco which to John Burnall in the County Court of Somerset  
before the Justices there of at Dividing Creek were adjudged for his damages which he had by reason of  
a certain promise and assumption to the same John by the afo<sup>d</sup> Benjamin made and not performed and that  
he should have the same tobacco before the Justices of the County Court of London to be held at Dividing

Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of June next to satisfy the afo<sup>d</sup> John of the damages of  
value of the same £110. And afterwards to wit the third Tuesday of June and Dated One hundred and  
hundred and thirty three came the said John Burnall by Francis Allen his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset  
County to whom the foregoing writ was directed comes and makes return thereof as followeth in these words  
following last: that he had made of the goods and Chattels of Benjamin Sharpe to the value of  
Eleven hundred and fifty three pounds of tobacco as appears by a schedule heretofore
