And Whereupon the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton by Francis Allen his Attorney Complains  
that Whereas the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland the thirtieth Day of March Anno Domini 1700  
hundred and thirty three at the County of Somerset aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court  
was Indebted unto the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton in one hundred fifty one pounds Seventeen  
Shillings and two pence half penny Curr<sup>t</sup> Money of Maryland for sundry properly  
Chargeable in Acc<sup>t</sup> as by Acc<sup>t</sup> thereof herunto Annexed may in Court appear  
and being so thereof Indebted the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland in Consideration thereof the day  
and year aforesaid at the place aforesaid upon himself Did Assume and to the said  
Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton then and there did faithfully Promise that he the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland  
the said one hundred fifty one pounds Seventeen Shillings and Two pence half  
penny to the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton when he should be afterwards therunto Requested  
he would well and faithfully pay and content and Altho the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland fifty  
Eight pounds & Six pence half penny parcel of y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid one hundred and fifty one  
pounds Seventeen Shillings and two pence half penny to the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton he  
hath paid and Satisfied yet unto Ninety three pounds Sixteen Shill<sup>ings</sup> and Eight pence  
Residue of the aforesaid one hundred and fifty one pounds Seventeen Shillings and  
two pence half penny the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland his promise and Assumption aforesaid  
in form aforesaid made Nothing Regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending  
the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton in that part Craftily & Subtly to decoit and Defraud the  
said Ninety three pounds Sixteen Shill<sup>ings</sup> and Eight pence to the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton  
Altho the same to do the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland by the aforesaid Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton on the aforesaid  
thirtieth Day of March in the year aforesaid and often afterwards at Somerset County within  
the Jurisdiction aforesaid he was therunto Requested hath not paid or Contented but the same to  
him hitherto to pay or Content hath Refused and Still doth Refuse and Deny. And Whereas  
also the aforesaid Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland afterwards to wit the aforesaid thirtieth day of March in the  
year aforesaid at the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid was Indebted unto the said  
Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton in nine pounds Nineteen Shill<sup>ings</sup> and Six pence Like Money for so much  
by the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton for the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland at the special Justice and Request  
of the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland To Thomas Lawrence Esq<sup>r</sup> Deposited & paid and being so  
thereof Indebted the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at  
the place aforesaid upon himself Did Assume and to the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton then and there  
did faithfully promise that he the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Holland the said nine pounds Nineteen Shill<sup>ings</sup>  
and Six pence to the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Bolton when he should be therunto Requested &c
